Dear Parents,

Following the update of the Government Policy yesterday, I am putting further measures in place. A few weeks ago, we began putting a plan in place for distance learning. We began to pool all of our resources both online resources and textbooks. This has taken a number of weeks to arrange and we have created learning packs for each child. The teachers have devised plans for distance learning in the event of a school closure.

Our Distance Learning Plan consists of 3 Phases

Phase 1 – This is for children who are in isolation at home.

Children can access online classroom learning using Google Classroom. Every class has a Google Classroom Page. I will be sending out logins and passwords for each child today. It will be on one document so please locate your child's name and use the login information. I am also sending out instructional videos on how to access it.

Once you login you will have access to your child's class page. This is where the teacher will post homework or work that the children are currently doing in class. Children that are isolating can access homework and other class activities from their Google Classroom Page. **Phase 1 starts from today.**

Phase 2 – In the event of a school closure, we have prepared learning packs for each child in the school. This will include an initial two week plan of work along with textbooks they need to work on. You can collect the workbooks for your child at the school. If you are isolating please ask a friend to pick it up for you. **The two week plan will also be posted on your child's Google Classroom page along with other activities that the teacher may post.**

Phase 3 – Extended closure

If the school needs to close for longer than two weeks then the class teacher will post additional work on the Google Classroom Page. The school office phone will be rerouted to my home and Mrs Hodnett's home. Please only contact this number in case of an emergency. Updates to parents will be by email, the school text messaging system and the school website.

We would appreciate:

I would appreciate if all OLOV families can take into consideration that our teachers and staff have families as well. Some teachers may have to isolate themselves, some may be ill and others may have to facilitate childcare of their own children including myself. In the event of an extended closure the teachers will post activities on the Google Classroom page when they are able to do so.
